Check before you connect.

·Look·

CATHETER:

• No cracks in the tubing.

• The caps are on the ends of the tubes.

• The cuff is not coming out of the skin.

EXIT SITE:

• No redness, drainage, bleeding, or exposure of the cuff.



CATHETER:

- Any problem with tubing.
- Hubs are exposed or dirty.
- Cuff is coming out of the skin.

EXIT SITE:

• Red, draining, or bleeding.

• Cuff is exposed.

• A stitch is still in place.

- (Check if it can be removed.)
- The skin over the tunnel is red.
